

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST- PROVISION OF CARBON EMMISION AND FUEL SAVINGS USING FUEL OPTIMIZERS.

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1. INTRODUCTION

Safaricom PLC is a leading telecommunications company offering a comprehensive range of integrated telecommunication services, including mobile and fixed Voice, SMS, Data, Internet, Mobile Money (M-PESA) and e-Commerce to over 30 million subscribers.

2. BACKGROUND

Some of the projects aimed at reducing net carbon emission is in growing trees, Solar to BTS and facilities and using efficient equipment's. We have some old equipments in our BTS and facilities like the generators and some vehicles that not efficient in carbon emission and fuel.

Our vision is to be a purpose-led technology company by 2025. In this aspect, we are continuously innovating and partnering with partners in new technology and innovations. In our quest to managing our impact on the environment and mitigating our environmental footprint, we are seeking for partners who have solutions on carbon emission savings and reducing fuel consumption in generators and vehicles.

The Carbon optimization should meet European standards (EC Normative 93/116, SAEJ1321) or equivalent. It should be a solid immersion device that functions inside the fuel tank. The equipment should not use power and is evaluated and approved by other international bodies/Kenya Bureau of standards (KEBS).
