1.1. Introduction

Safaricom Plc is the leading integrated communication and financial services provider in Kenya, with a steadily growing subscriber base. The company is continuously expanding and reviewing its business, to meet the changing competitive landscapes, needs, and profiles of its customers.

Our efforts are geared towards positively impacting the lives of those in the communities around us and thus we strive to change the present to improve the future.

To this end, Safaricom Plc intends to engage services of reputable supplier(s) for the **Provision of Construction Consultancy for Safaricom and Mpesa Foundation Projects.** Safaricom is therefore soliciting for Expressions of Interest (EOI) from interested qualified providers.

1.2. Background and EOI Requirements

Safaricom outsources Construction consultancy services to professional firms, who offer specialized services in line with agreed terms of reference. This requirement is for the identification of a suitable firm(s) to offer Construction Consultancy for Safaricom and Mpesa Foundation Projects.

A summary of the terms of reference for this requirement is summarized below:

SCOPE OF THE ASSIGNMENT

Projects Description

Safaricom & Mpesa Foundations approve grants to beneficiaries that range from construction to supply of goods and equipment. The most common projects include construction of classrooms, science laboratories, dormitories, construction of Health facilities, renovation works, boreholes drilling and equipping, construction of latrines, installation of water tanks and water harvesting systems for schools, supply of medical equipment, supply of books and furniture to learning institutions among others. The consultant shall be responsible for preparing detailed designs and supervision of all projects assigned. The detailed designs shall be based on design brief provided by Safaricom & Mpesa Foundations.



Major Tasks and Responsibilities

The assignment shall cover the following professional services:

- 1. Architectural services
- 2. Structural Engineering
- 3. Quantity Surveying
- 4. Projects implementation supervision

The assignment period shall be for an initial duration of 2 years subject to annual evaluation unless advised otherwise by Safaricom & Mpesa Foundations.

During projects implementation the consultant shall undertake the following activities:

- Understand and interpret Safaricom & Mpesa Foundation's requirements.
- Constitute a project team with the relevant skills
- Carry out site analysis of the projects' sites
- Prepare design reports including requisite services.
- The consultant shall be required to take into consideration the following building concepts: functionality and design requirements, cooling efficiency, energy efficiency, innovation and minimization of operation and maintenance costs.
- Upon approval of Preliminary design by Safaricom/Mpesa Foundation, prepare detailed architectural, electrical, structural, mechanical and interiors layout drawings
- Prepare technical specifications.
- Prepare Bills of Quantities for the construction works including confidential cost estimates of different work packages.
- Prepare Tender Documents for both construction and supplies works.
- Assist with the tendering process including running of the pre-tender site visit
 and meeting; drafting minutes of the meeting including responses to questions
 raised during the visit; analyzing the different technical and arithmetic tender
 proposals; drafting tender evaluation report.
- Provide project management services including supervision of construction and supplies works
- Monitor and control the quality of materials for construction by employing clerk of works for the assigned sites
- Ensure that health and safety requirements are complied with.
- Maintain close liaison with Safaricom/Mpesa Foundation and with other stakeholders as may be required for performance of services.



- Ensure compliance with Local Building By-laws, Building code, physical planning act and other applicable statutory requirements and regulations,
- Participate in joint meetings and site visits with Safaricom/Mpesa Foundation
- Uphold community engagement and ensure proper stakeholder management and compliance with ISO 26000 (Corporate Social responsibility)
- Aid on dispute resolution when it arises between two or more parties.
- Prepare as-built drawings and oversee submission of completion reports and/or handover/closeout documentation at practical completion stage. Liaise with the relevant statutory bodies/approving authorities to facilitate and process all statutory approvals where needed for the projects. These include but not limited to;
 - NEMA approvals
 - KCAA approvals
 - WARMA approvals
 - Local Authority Planning approvals
