



Safaricom Golf Tour 2022

CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR CORPORATE DAY

1. The tournament shall be an 18-Hole Stableford competition played off the regular men and ladies tees. Each qualifying round and the National Final will be played over 18 holes.
2. Every player must have a valid World Handicap System (WHS) Handicap Index, present their CDH ID on registration and play off 95% of their Course Handicap as on the day of the tournament and start of play.
3. The Safaricom Golf Tour is open to hosting club members, reciprocating club members and Safaricom invited guests on first come first served basis. Safaricom will send names of its guests to the hosting club by Tuesday of the week of the event.
4. The total field shall be restricted to a maximum of 200 players for 18 Hole Courses and 100 Players for 9 Hole Courses. There will be strictly no tee offs allowed after 14.00 hrs.
5. **Lateness:** Players must adhere to their tee-off times as on the draw. Players who are 2-minutes late will incur a 2-point penalty. Players who are 5-mins late, or more, will NOT be allowed to participate. The Starter's Clock shall be deemed correct.
6. The Overall Winner, Men's Winner and Ladies' Winner at each Safaricom Corporate Day event will qualify for the Grand Finale in August 2022 at Vipingo Ridge Golf Resort. Safaricom will pay return flights (out of Nairobi) and accommodation for 2 nights for each finalist to play in the Grand Finale.
7. The entry fee for each qualifying round is as per Club charges; payable directly to the host club. An optional ball pool shall be available - hosting club charges apply. As per the Kenya Golf Union By-Laws, Kshs 100/- of the entry fee will be paid to the Kenya Golf Union by the hosting Golf towards Junior Golf Foundation.
8. Caddy fees are to be met by the player.
9. The pace of play must be observed as per the tee times.
10. **Closing Dates for Receiving Entries:** Entries shall close on **Tuesday, 12 Noon** on the week of the event. The draw will be done by the host club and shared to the members and reciprocating clubs, the Press and Safaricom by **Wednesday, 7pm** on the week of the event.



11. All COVID and Security Protocols to be adhered to at all times.

12. Event Organizers have the right of admission.

14. No player may win more than one prize.

15. In the event of a tie for any position, count-back will be over the last nine, last six, last three or last hole on the card.

16. Participants must be present during the prize giving ceremony. No show, no prize. In case of an emergency, a player may seek permission from the Golf Captain of the hosting club.



Actions by the Hosting Club

1. The Host Club Captain shall liaise closely with Safaricom and/or Safaricom's representative to ensure a successful organization of the event.
2. Where applicable, the Host Club will invite the Affiliate Clubs to play in the event and ensure that the draw is done accordingly.
3. Safaricom has offered a prize for the Winner's Caddy. The prize will be presented during the main prizing ceremony. Hosting clubs are requested to make dispensations for the winning caddy to attend the prize-giving event to receive the prize.
4. The hosting club will work closely with Safaricom to invite the local media to attend the event and the prize giving ceremony as a way of getting publicity for the club and the sponsor.
5. The hosting club will provide Safaricom with a suggested budget for catering 2 weeks prior to the event date; Through its Event Agency (or otherwise informed in writing) Safaricom will issue an LPO and after receipt of invoice; the bill (shall be settled within) 14 days of receipt of invoice.
6. The Host Club shall ensure adequate security is in place for the events.
7. The Host Club will assist Safaricom with personnel to brand the Golf Course and Club House areas.

Maximum entries per event:

18 Hole Courses: 200 pax (60% Host Club/ 40% Safaricom)

9 Hole Courses: 100 pax (60% Host Club/ 40% Safaricom)
