Additional requirements (these carry less weight in your application):

- The applicant should be able to play any chosen instrument. *
- The applicant should be able to read music.
- The applicant should have knowledge of music theory.

In addition to the chosen instrument, applicants are encouraged to bring and demonstrate their ability on any other instruments they play. Students who play traditional instruments in addition to their chosen instrument are welcome. Students who play, or are willing to play, rare instruments such as Oboe, Viola, Bassoon, Cello & Double Bass are especially encouraged to audition.

- 3. Audition requirements:

In addition to the application form, all applicants are required to record and submit two pieces of music with different styles/musical periods:

i. The recording should be a 2-3 minute video.
 ii. The recording must have good sound quality and a clear image of the applicant playing their instrument.
