1. Introduction and Background

- DCH and FCH services offered and any other feature that will form part of dc/fc service.
- Roaming Hubbing services if available and the details of connectivity, coverage included.
- Roaming workflow/management platform or any other RMS (Roaming Management Service) tool used to manage daily roaming workflow.
- Roaming analytics solution and its features that provide commercial and technical insights.

3. The EOI Scope

This EOI is intended to identify reputable and qualified suppliers who will be able to deliver on the scope (but is not limited to) below: Specifically, the solution should be able to;

1. Integrate with Safaricom's existing systems, network elements and firewalls.



- 2. Provide signalling and IPX connectivity seamlessly and redundantly
- 3. Provide any other services offered related to roaming
- 4. Provide detailed reports showing analytics, MSU count, connectivity modes and data that guides during key decision making.
- 5. The full details of the scope of the signaling and IPX provision will be provided in an RFP (Request for Proposal) that will be sent out to bidders shortlisted through this EOI process.
